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I just bought an imac at walmart today but it came with a disc that can only restore it to the 3.4.4 os. I bought a 2.5gb disk that says it can restore the 3.4.4 to 10.4.5. I am going to wipe the 3.4.4 and install the 10.4.5. I would like to know if i will be able to use any of the programs that came with the 3.4.4 disc. And also will i be able to add any of the new features in 10.4.5. Thanks. Ok, so in reading about the restore disc, I learned that there is a new version of os X that's available if you already have a disc for 3.4.4. I found a place that had the version 10.4.5 free of charge, so I'm going to go ahead and download it and try it on the imac. I will post back when I'm done with the install. If you have the 3.4.4 disc, that's probably a good idea to get the latest version of OS X on your imac. You have a version of OS X that's a little older than the one that is on the disc. This is because the disc itself is also an upgrade disc. If you installed the older OS X, it was the version that came with your machine when you bought it. If you then upgraded to OS X 10.4.5, you may still have the version that came with your machine. If so, the disc is just a guide to help you install the newer version. What you are asking is whether the disc you have will work with the newer version of OS X on your imac. If so, you should not have any trouble using it. Ok, so in reading about the restore disc, I learned that there 82157476af

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
